- In-ground and above ground pools that are designed to hold 24 inches or more of water, including temporary blow-up pools.
- Covered or uncovered decks, patios and porches
- Sheds or other outbuildings
- Attached and detached garages
- Driveways (Concrete or asphalt paved)
- ♦ New Electrical Services
- ANY addition or structural renovation to an existing residential structure
- Retaining walls 4 ft. or higher
- Fences over 6 ft. high (permit not required if less than 6 ft.)



- Be sure to check with BCO Mike Hammers @ 717-870-7753 before beginning any projects on your property to see if a permit is required, and for other permitting and zoning questions, including Realty & other signage.

Following are the Rules & Regulations <u>you must</u> <u>abide by according to</u> Jacobus Borough's 'Solid Waste' Ordinance:



- Containers shall be set at the curb line of the street by 6:00 am of the day of collection, but no earlier than 5:00 pm of the day prior to the day of collection. Empty containers shall be removed from the curb on the day of collection after collection.
- Collection is 1X p/week, on Tuesday, for both refuse & recycling.
- 8 containers/bags may be placed curbside p/week.
- 1 large trash item may be placed curbside p/week. (Please contact Penn Waste, Inc. directly for items too large for their regular truck crew to handle.)
- No person shall place garbage, rubbish or other waste on a tract of real estate for collection other than what has originated on the tract of real estate.
- Violators may be cited and required to appear before the District Magistrate for failing to comply with Borough Ordinance.

When sitting out your trash & recycling, PLEASE remember to sit your bags or containers within the curb line, NOT in the street. Sitting it in the street

is a hazard to public safety.

Jacobus Borough is a MS4 (Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems) community and is covered by the DEP's (Department of Environmental Protection) General Stormwater NPDES Permit (PAG-13). Any activities that change the characteristics of stormwater runoff must be developed in accordance with the Borough's Stormwater Management Ordinance. - Within the 25 ft. sight triangle at intersections
- On Utility Poles or Municipal Sign Posts
- On private property without the owner's permission
- All signs must be removed within 24 hours of the completion of your sale.

Those who do not comply with the Borough's Rules & Regulation may be cited.

Should you desire to clean up the gravel on any roads bordering your property, or on your property, please feel free to dump it on the walking paths either at Jacobus Community Park or the community 'Tot Lot' Park in Wellington Hills. The Borough will take care of spreading any gravel dumped on the paths.
