It's only a few weeks until Spring and most of us are looking forward to longer and warmer days

ahead. As you read on from the first CHILLY article, may you find warmth in the early signs of Spring.

WINTER 2012-2013

Jacobus Borough's Winter Maintenance costs for the 2012-2013 season-to-date totaled \$18,105.00.

Every year Pennsylvania municipalities receive a distribution from the State's Motor Fuels Tax Funds collected in the prior year. Allocation amounts for the Liquid Fuel funds are based on the number of miles of streets and the population within the municipality– the streets must meet particular PA DOT

specs for size to be included in the mileage. Jacobus Borough has 5.68 street miles and a population of 1841. The Borough's Liquid Fuels Tax allocation for 2013 is estimated to be 34,774.60. The funds are highly regulated by the Dept. of Transportation for approved uses and are audited every two years. Jacobus Borough's actual allocation, received on April 1st of each year, is used mainly for the approved expense of winter maintenance.

Want to get rid of unwanted gravel left-over from snow removal? Clean it up & take it to Jacobus Community Park. There you can dump & spread it on the Walking Path. It helps you, and saves the Borough the cost of purchasing gravel for the path.

2013 Budget

* * * * * * * * * * * * * * * *

Jacobus Borough's 2013 Budget was approved for adoption at the December 5, 2012 Borough Council meeting. The 2013 budget is \$489,432.00, an increase of \$38,356.00 from the 2012 budget of \$451,076.00. The millage rate of 1.7 mils for Local Real Estate taxes will remain the same for 2013. Following are items in the Borough's 2013 General Fund budget showing a significant increase or decrease from 2012:

- General Government Administration (Equipment): \$7,630.00; Increase of \$3,975.00
- Engineering Services: \$14,000.00; Decrease of \$1,500.00
- General Government Buildings & Grounds: \$6,875.00; Decrease of \$4,649.00
- York Area Regional Police (Service Contract): \$74,000.00; Increase of \$2,866.00
- State Allocated Fireman's Relief Funds: \$11,700.00; Decrease of \$8,800.00
- Ordinance Codification: \$5,700.00; Increase of \$4,750.00
- Public Works-Sanitation (Refuse/Recycling/Sewage): \$136,666.00; Increase of \$1,789.00
- Winter Maintenance: \$10,000.00; Decrease of \$5,000.00
- Traffic Control Devices: \$2,500.00; Increase of \$1,326.00
- Street Lighting: \$22,100.00; Decrease of \$1,900.00
- Storm Water: \$3,500.00; Increase of \$3,500.00
- Maintenance & Repair of Roads: \$8,500.00; Increase of \$1,026.00
- Highway Construction & Rebuilding: \$43,759.00; Increase of \$43,759.00
- JLS Recreation Association: \$4,359.00; Increase of \$1,117.00
- Unclassified Expenses: \$1,492.00; Decrease of \$2,419.00

Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4)

Jacobus Borough is a MS4 community and is covered by the DEP's (Dept. of Environmental Protection) General Storwater NPDES Permit (PAD-13). Any activities that change the characteristics of storm water runoff must be developed in accordance with the Borough's Stormwater Management Ordinance. Stormwater Ordinance

Jacobus Borough was required to adopt a new Stormwater Ordinance in order to comply with current Federal EPA* and PA DEP** Stormwater regulations related to improving water quality in the Chesapeake Bay Watershed. With adoption of this ordinance additional costs are incurred with most outdoor building and impervious surface projects. In addition to a Building Permit, anytime impervious surface over 100 square feet is added to your property a Stormwater Permit and a Stormwater Management Plan is required. Examples of projects possibly requiring a Stormwater Permit and Management Plan are, but not limited to: New Building Construction, Additions, Storage Shed, Garage or Car Port, Deck, Gazebo, Driveways, Driveway Extensions or Parking Pads. **Residents and Businesses should contact Jacobus Borough's Building Code Official PRIOR TO beginning ANY outdoor impervious construction project**. Significant penalties are in place for those involved with projects which are not in compliance. The requirements mandated by the EPA and DEP are a result of the departments' Chesapeake Bay Watershed Initiative to 'Save the Bay'.

BUILDING PERMIT INFORMATION

Springtime brings project time. Are you getting ready to improve your home and/or property? Below is a basic list of projects you must obtain a permit for. However it is not a complete list, so be sure to contact Jacobus Borough's Building Code Official/Zoning Officer PRIOR to beginning any projects on your property. Those beginning work without a permit when required may, at minimum, be ordered to stop work & have their permit fees doubled.

Permits and Inspections are required by PA Uniform Construction Code and Local Regulation for the following residential projects:

- In-ground and above ground pools that are designed to hold 24 inches or more of
 - water, <u>including temporary blow-up pools.</u>
- Covered or uncovered decks, patios and porches
- Sheds or other outbuildings
- Attached and detached garages
- Driveways (Concrete or Asphalt paved)
- New Electrical Services
- ANY addition or structural renovation to an existing residential structure
- Retaining walls 4 ft. or higher
- Fences over 6 ft. high (permit not required if less than 6 ft.)



*Always call PA One Call at 811before you dig!

OTHER PERMITS

According to Jacobus Borough Ordinance, permits are required for the following:

- Yard Sales You are allowed one (1) Yard Sale permit within a 12 month period. The permit cost is \$10.00 and is good for up to 3 consecutive days from dawn to dusk. Advertising your sale? Please be sure to check the Borough's Signage regulations prior to placing signs in Jacobus by contacting the Municipal Office or on the Borough's website: <u>www.jacobuspa.com</u>. Jacobus Borough offers 'FREE' yard sale days 3 times per year during holiday weekends. In 2013, the 'free' yard sale dates are: <u>Memorial Day Weekend</u> Friday, May 24th thru Monday, May 27th; July 4th Holiday Weekend July 5th thru July 7th; Labor Day Weekend Friday, August 30th thru Monday, September 2nd.
- <u>Alarm Permits</u> Permits are required for the use of an automatic dialing device, alarm device or outdoor audible



alarm. An alarm which produces both a fire and burglar alarm shall be considered separate, thereby requiring two (2) permits. There is a one-time registration fee of \$20.00 for the Alarm permit. It is the residents response bility to acquire the permit and to inform the Borough of any changes to the device, including deactivation of the device.

• <u>Transient Retail Merchant License</u> (aka TRML <u>or</u> Solicitation Permit) - Any person, firm or corporation, including local non-profits, desiring to engage in transient retail business in Jacobus Borough MUST obtain a license from Jacobus Borough. The license fee varies in price, from \$10.00 to \$50.00, depending on the period of time for which the license is issued.



Persons not following 'other' permit requirements may be cited by the Police and issued a fine up to \$600.00 by the District Magistrate.

REMEMBER... Businesses and Individuals are required to obtain a Permit issued by Jacobus Borough prior to performing Transient Retail Business within the Borough. Permittees must carry the permit with them while doing business, so be sure to ask to see it any time a Solicitor comes onto your property. Only permits issued by Jacobus Borough are valid in the Borough. Please Call 911 immediately when approached by a Solicitor who cannot produce a valid permit, if you see them continue to solicit once leaving your property, and for any other problem you might have with a Solicitor such as not leaving when asked to do so. York Area Regional Police are actively enforcing Jacobus Borough's Transient Retail License Ordinance and have cited Solicitors for non-compliance. Occasional arrests have been made of individuals who were found to have outstanding warrants when stopped for non-compliant soliciting in Jacobus Borough.

PURTA

Local taxing authorities are encouraged to annually file a 'Tax Receipt Information' report to be considered for a distribution of the Commonwealth's "Realty Tax Equivalent" (RTE) funds through PURTA (Public Utility Realty Tax Agency), a unit of the Bureau of Corporation Taxes at the PA Department of Revenue. The total "RTE" is based on consideration of adjustments made to prior years' realty tax equivalent(s) resulting from continuing resolutions of utility real estate tax appeals throughout the Commonwealth. Jacobus Borough received \$639.39 for its 2012 report filed for Year 2011.



Jacobus Community Park

Did you know there are other parks in Jacobus for your enjoyment? If you enjoy hiking or just enjoy spending time with nature, visit the Nature Park in "The Woods at Lake Redman" neighborhood. It is a grassy area which connects to the YC Park Trail and at the right time of day or evening it is not unusual to see deer in the area. You can access the park from the parking lot at the end of E. Branch Drive and also by the grass right-of-way at the Cul-de-Sac on E. Greenbriar Drive.

If you want to give your kids a change of pace, visit the Tot-Lot at the corner of Stonewood Drive and Farmington Drive in the Wellington Hills neighborhood. Turn right onto Woodland Drive off of Valley Road and make a left onto Stonewood Drive. The Tot-Lot will be on your left.



As of January 24, 2013, under the Pennsylvania "Covered Device Recycling Act" (Act 108), Penn Waste, Inc. is no longer allowed to collect your electronic waste. Act 108 also prohibits residents and businesses from placing their electronic waste at the curb or in the trash.

"Covered" and other electronic devices include, but are not limited to: Cell Phones, Desktop Computers, Laptops, Monitors, Computer Peripherals (Keyboard, mouse, printer and speakers), Televisions, Microwave Oven, Electric Typewriter, Stereo Equipment, E-Readers that browse the internet.

The York County Solid Waste Authority accepts "covered" and other electronic devices during its monthly Electronics Recycling Collection on the third Saturday of every month. Following is a list of locations within a 10 mile radius of Jacobus Borough which accept E-Cyclables from both residents and non-residents :

Every year Jacobus Borough applies for a Municipal Recycling Program Performance Grant. The grant is based on the tonnage of Commercial and Residential recyclable items collected in the Borough for a one year period. \$1,076.00 was received for the grant applied for in 2012 for year 2011 recycling data.
